



Anson County, NC *Facts* at a glance



- Anson County has a population of 19,973.
- There are 4,235 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 21.2% of the population.
- There are 652 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 15.7% of the older adult population.
- There are 1,551 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 35.5% of the child population.

Anson County Distribution

In 2024-2025, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 2.3 million pounds to agencies in Anson County.

Anson County Partners

The Food Bank supports 22 programs in Anson County including Anson County Partnership for Children, Anson Crisis Ministry, Feed My Lambs, Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center, and Ebenezer Baptist Church.

Child Hunger Programs

Anson County has a Kids Café and Backpack Program site located at Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center. In addition to the Backpack Program at Burnsville, Second Harvest also provides backpacks for schools throughout the county.
