

Spartanburg County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- Spartanburg County has a population of 330,155.
- There are 47,882 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14.5% of the population.
- There are 6,360 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 11.9% of the older adult population.
- There are 15,238 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19.5% of the child population.

Spartanburg County Distribution

In 2024-2025, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 5.1 million pounds to agencies in Spartanburg County.

Spartanburg County Partners

The Food Bank supports 40 programs in Spartanburg County including Greater Spartanburg Ministries, Helping Hands Ministry of Woodruff, Church Builders, Carpenters Table, Greater St James, The Bridge at Green Street, and St. Matthews Episcopal.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank sponsors several Backpack Programs in Spartanburg County.

Spartanburg Branch

The Food Bank opened a new branch in Spartanburg County in May of 2010. This branch has greatly reduced the time and transportation costs for Spartanburg, Union and Cherokee Counties in South Carolina to acquire food. Recently, this branch shifted its schedule to full time, 5 days per week.
