



York County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- York County, SC has a population of 284,017.
- There are 25,243 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8.9% of the population.
- There are 3,596 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 8.4% of the older adult population.
- There are 7,666 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 11.3% of the child population.

York County Distribution

In 2024-2025, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 5.5 million pounds to agencies in York County.

York County Partners

The Food Bank supports 117 programs in York County including P.A.T.H., Fort Mill Care Center, HOPE, Dorothy Day Soup Kitchen, York County Council on Aging, and The Community Cafe.

Child Hunger Programs

York County has Kids Café sites located within Boys & Girls Club facilities in Rock Hill, York, and Fort Mill. The Food Bank also provides Backpack Programs throughout the Rock Hill, Fort Mill, York and Clover school districts. The Food Bank annually sponsors numerous school mobile pantries in conjunction with the Rock Hill School District.

Senior Hunger Programs

The Second Helping Program provides monthly boxes of food to homebound seniors in York County. The Food Bank provides the boxes, which are delivered by the York County Council on Aging.
